The City Council of Lake City, Iowa met in regular session on Monday, December 19, 2011 at 6:30 P.M. at the Community Building. Mayor Hying presided with the following members present: Himes, Green, Sheffield\*, and Kramer; absent: Bellinghausen,. Department heads/staff present: Jim Janssen, Melvin Alcox, Norma DeVries, Officer Curran. *Pledge of Allegiance* was recited.

City Administrator distributed copies and reviewed the Burning Survey results. Approximately 34% of the surveys were returned with 63.3% in favor of six days, 20.8% in favor of three days, and 15.9% in favor of a burn ban. Brian Davis addressed the council, explaining his support for three burn days/week during the burn season. Brian also indicated a need for regulations pertaining to recreational fires. Bob Poen stated he would not like to see burning banned. It was noted that several comments were made on the surveys about the hardship on elderly having to drive to the rural yard waste site. After some discussion, motion by Green, second by Himes, to further research options for leaf and garden waste disposal, in addition to recreational fire guideline, unanimous.

Administrator Kelly reported the results from the November 8 election: Mayor- Gary Fahan, City Council - Gary Bellinghausen and Mathew Ringenberg. All positions are four-year terms, commencing January 1, 2012.

Mayor Hying thanked the Council, staff, and citizens of Lake City for the 4-year term he served as Mayor. Council expressed appreciation to Mayor Hying and Councilman Sheffield for their service to the community.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Kramer and seconded by Green to adjourn at 6:45 PM, unanimous.
