# **VENDOR RESOLUTION**

SECTION 1: This resolution as amended is enacted to help city officials and citizens deal with the public health and safety problems created by the infusion of a large number of people into the City of Any Town when the Des Moines Register's Annual Great Bicycle Ride Across Iowa™ (RAGBRAI®) arrives in Lake City on July 26, 2021, and departs on July 26, 2021.

#### SECTION2: Miscellaneous Permits

<u>Commercial Booth - Permit Required.</u> No person, club, group, organization, corporation or entity of any kind shall provide or sell food to the public in Lake City on July 26, 2021 unless said person or entity shall first obtain a Commercial Booth Permit from the City of Lake City through the City Clerk located at 105 N Center Stt in Lake City, Iowa.

Commercial Booth Fees. The fee for a Lake City Commercial Booth Permit shall be \$250.00. Booth space is 20' x 10'.

<u>Commercial Booth Location</u>. A vendor who has been granted a Lake City Commercial Booth permit shall locate its temporary sale facility at a location to be determined by the official Lake City RAGBRAI Committee.

<u>Health Regulations</u>. A person or entity issued a commercial booth permit pursuant to this Chapter (a RAGBRAI COMMERCIAL BOOTH PERMITTEE herein) shall comply with the Iowa Department of Health and Buena Vista County Department of Health rules and regulations pertaining to the sale and dispensing of food for consumption on its premises.

<u>Glass Containers.</u> To promote safety during RAGBRAI, all beverages sold in Lake City, Iowa, by Commercial Booth permittees, on July 26, 2021 and until 2:30 p.m. on July 26, 2021, shall be sold in non-glass containers only. This requirement shall also apply to any existing business, restaurant, service station, grocery store or other establishment selling beverages on its premises in an outdoor setting open to the public.

<u>Nuisance</u>. The sale of food or the erection of a temporary facility for the sale of food or other merchandise withouta Lake City Commercial Booth or Lake City Commercial Booth Non-Food permit on July 26, 2021, in violation of the provisions of this Chapter shall be considered a nuisance, as defined by Section of the City Code of Ordinances. is determined to exist, an emergency abatement procedure pursuant to Title 111, Chapter 2 of the City Code is hereby authorized and may be executed by any peace officer or those acting at their direction by dismantling and removing the nuisance without notice. However, if the only nuisance or violation of this chapter is the offender's failure to obtain the necessary permit, the RAGBRAI Committee, in lieu of immediate abatement, may allow the person or organization to immediately purchase (cash only) a necessary permit as provided by this Ordinance.

<u>Violations - Penalties</u>. Selling or supplying food or merchandise to any person without a Lake City Commercial Booth or Lake City Commercial Booth Non-Food permit on July 26, 2021, or any violation of this chapter shall be a simple misdemeanor punishable by a maximum fine of \$500.00 and/or a maximum of thirty (30) days in Jail. Furthermore, any violation of this Chapter shall constitute a municipal infraction, as set forth in Title 1 Chapter 4 of the City Code of Ordinances, and, therefore, any civil penalties may likewise be assessed and enforced as set forth.

**Effective Period.** The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective from 5:00 a.m. (local time) on July 26, 2021 until 5:00 p.m. (local time) on July 26, 2021.

<u>Street Closings.</u> During the effective dates of this ordinance and without prior Council approval regarding the blocking of any city streets, any Lake City Police Officer, or those at their direction, may place barricades or road blocks in any City street, alley or roadway to redirect vehicular traffic in order to enhance the proper and safe flow of bicycle and vehicular traffic.

Aircraft, all acts of terrorism, asbestos liability, claims made by athletic participants, employment related practices, fungi and bacteria, hepatitis, HIV, HTVL, AIDS, transmissible spongiform encephalopathy, lead poisoning, nuclear energy liability, pyrotechnics activity, total pollution, violation of the CAN-SPAM act, war liability and liability for occurrences prior to the effective date of coverage. All of the above are subject to the terms and conditions of the policy.
